

## LET'S STOP WERT BILL

The preliminary project of the Organic Law of Improvement of Education Quality (OLIEQ - In Spanish LOMCE: Ley Orgánica de Mejora de la Calidad Educativa.), which the Government has recently introduced, is in serious breach of the model of public education that so laboriously has been built in our country as:

- > It infringes the right to equal opportunities
- > It excludes the pupils with the greatest learning difficulties
- > It allows or promotes the segregation for sex, beliefs or origin
- > It threatens teachers' professionalism
- > It neglects people's necessities and forces us to submit to the rules of companies and bankers
- > It does not guarantee people's education as citizens but as workers
- > It abolishes participatory democracy
- > It ignores the differences among the autonomous communities and infringes their competences
- > It rejects the principles and criteria that have enabled our country to make progress in education

The education community, the citizens, demand the withdrawal of the preliminary project of the Organic Law of Improvement of Education Quality (OLIEQ) and call for the drafting of a law that comes from the dialogue and agreement of all the parties concerned, as only in this way it will ensure stability and, as in our neighbouring countries, fulfil the social role that education must have.
